This wine is firm and still young. However, it is already showing signs of the ripe black fruits and wood aging. Acidity and the firm structure will let the wine age. Drink from 2020.

86. The 2014 Lestage has a crisp bouquet with blackberry, cedar and almost granitic scents that are well defined, quite "punchy" in style. The palate is medium-bodied with slightly chunky tannin, a masculine Lustrac with good grip, solid if missing some finesse towards the finish. Tasted September 2016.
